Four challenges at Skandia

Skandia bank and insurance has offered digital meeting points earlier but lacked a well-planned office, a real physical meeting point. A new type of bank experience more inspired by shops than traditional bank offices is now to visit at Kungsgatan in Stockholm. To give nature more space the design agency BVD designed a plant wall 4,5 meters high, on top of an elevator, at a staircase rounding the corner – four challenges for us at Greenworks in the same project! Now clients and staff enjoy the dense ivy that adds oxygen and turn the office into a natural, lively environment.
